Assault by Auto Investigation

Chief William Swanhart announced today that an investigation into an assault by an automobile, which occurred on Sunday, September 21, 2025, has resulted in the arrest of the driver.

Kyle Pound, 23, of Matawan, New Jersey, is charged with one count of second-degree aggravated assault, two counts of fourth-degree assault by auto, one count of third-degree endangering an injured victim, one count of third-degree leaving the scene with serious injury, and related motor vehicle offenses.

On Sunday evening, September 21, 2025, Robbinsville Police received calls reporting an illegal car meet on Applegate Drive. After officers arrived on scene, approximately (50) cars dispersed from the area. Following an investigation by the Criminal Investigations Unit, a 16-year-old victim and an 18-year-old were identified after being run over by a vehicle operated by Pound.

Pound is being held by the Mercer County Correctional Center, pending court proceedings.
